Hong Kong Scout Centennial Building
Terms and Regulations for Climbing Activities

(Mar 2020)

1. Location
 - a) Climbing walls are located at 7/F covered terrace.
 - b) Two climbing walls (Climbing Wall I, II) are located at Covered Training Terrace 703A and 703C. The climbing wall with the connected covered terrace will be rent together.

2. Opening Hour & Increment Weather
 - a) Monday – Sunday from 09:00 to 22:00, except 1st-3rd day of Lunar New Year.
 - b) Non-peak hours: 9am to 6pm for weekdays and 9am to 1pm for Saturdays, except public holiday.
 - c) Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or above, Red or Black Rainstorm Warning is issued, the venue will be closed.

3. Eligibility, Charge and Regulations for Climbing Activities
 - a) Minimum of 2 hours per booking (per wall per use).
 - b) Maximum capacity of each climbing is 8 persons. Instructor is not included.
 - c) Eligibility for use
 - i) Users have to hold CHKMCU Level II Sport Climbing Certification or above.
 - ii) If users cannot meet (i) requirement, users have to be accompanied by the coach who hold CHKMCU Level I Instructor of Sport Climbing Certification or above, or has equivalent qualification recognized by Scout Association of Hong Kong. The ratio of instructor to users should be 1:8.
 - iii) Minimum 2 eligible persons is required to present when using the top rope climbing facility.
 - d) If non- scout organization would like to use the climbing facilities, they have to reserve a function room with the same or more rental hour as using the climbing facilities. The climbing facilities alone are not available to be reserved by non- scout organization.
 - e) Users shall provide the copy of related certificate(s) during reservation. Also, they have to present the room booking permit and related certificate(s) in G/F lobby for registration and checking on the event date.
 - f) Users shall set up safety gymnastic mat before climbing. Please return the mat to the original location after use. The venue should be returned in normal condition within the reserved timeslot.
 - g) Users have to use climbing protection gear and equipment which meet requirement from UIAA. Users should bring their own top rope, climbing protection gear and equipment.
 - h) Minimum one accompanying person is required to give protection to the user when bouldering.
 - i) It is necessary to have partners for climbing.
 - j) It is prohibited to add or remove any handle, tape and ribbon to change the preset route in the climbing wall.
 - k) Users should wear appropriate sportswear.
 - l) Users should be aware of their health condition and avoid excessive exercise/ over-exercising.
 - m) Venue and Facility Charge (Per wall per use)

4. Regulations for users

- a) Users must comply with Terms and Regulations from Scout Association of Hong Kong and follow the instruction from property officer.
- b) Users are required to present the room booking permit and related certificate(s) for checking on the event date.
- c) Users must treasure all public facilities and ensure the equipment is secured before use.
- d) Users is prohibited to use additional amenities in the building without approval from Estate Branch.
- e) Offensive language, noise making and disturbing behavior are forbidden in the building.
- f) User is not allowed to wear any earphone or accessories affecting hearing during climbing.
- g) Alcohol and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. Persons under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs are not allowed to use building facilities. Settled payment will not be refunded.
- h) Any dangerous behavior is forbidden.
- i) Users must inform property officer immediately if there is any emergency.
- j) Users must clean up and bring away their personal belongings after using the venue.
- k) It is illegal for anyone to occupy the venue beyond opening hours.

5. Patrol in the building

Officer will regularly patrol in the building to check the activities are conducted legally.

6. Disclaimer

- a) Users must comply with Terms and Regulations from Scout Association of Hong Kong.
- b) Users should mind their belongings and avoid bringing valuables to the building. The Association is not responsible for any loss.
- c) Users should take fully responsible for the risk of injuries or loss caused to the others or the Association.
- d) Commercial activities will be prohibited without prior approval of Estate Branch.
- e) Illegal behavior are strictly forbidden.
- f) Children aged under 12 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or above. The adult will assume full responsibility and liability for their children while on the premises.
- g) Users should ensure the security of personal climbing equipment. The Association is not responsible for any damages of the equipment.
- h) The Association reserves the right to claim the compensation of any loss of the property or facilities.
- i) The Association reserves the right to request users to leave the venue.
- j) The Association reserves the right to modify above regulations without notice.
- k) The Association has sole and final discretion of interpretation of these Terms and Conditions.
